SECURITY PROCEDURE

of Music Hub Academy in Warsaw during the sanitary regime caused by COVID-19 pandemic in the school year 2020/2021

- 1. Music Hub Academy a Non-Public Education and Upringing Institution and a Non-Public Institution for Continuing Education resumes functioning in line with the guidelines of the Chief Sanitary Inspector, Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education. The aim of the procedure is to minimize the risk of infection COVID-19.
- 2. This procedure shall apply at the Music Academy in Warsaw.
- 3. Only students without symptoms suggestive of an infection of the respiratory tract and whose family members (or those who live in the same household) are not in quarantine or isolation can attend the school.
- 4. Students can be brought into Music Hub by parents/guardians who have no symptoms suggestive of infection of the respiratory tract. On the way to and from school caregivers of the children and the students respect the current laws concerning behavior in public space.
- 5. Staying inside the school for those not attending classes is limited to a minimum. If you wish to speak with us, it is recommended to contact us by telephone or by e-mail.
- 6. At the entrance to the facility you can find a liquid hand sanitizer, which is mandatory for anyone entering the school.
- 7. If there is need for a third person to enter the school, please keep extra precautions and recommendations sanitary regime:
 - Maintain a distance of 1.5 meter
 - Covering the nose and mouth
 - Compulsory disinfection of hands
 - The limited movement within the premises
 - Limited contact with employees of school
- 8. People who are sick, staying in quarantine or isolation are not allowed to enter the school.
- 9. In the teaching rooms, there is no obligation of covering the mouth and nose only in common areas.
- 10. Children are asked to wash their hands using soap and water as often as possible.
- 11. Teaching rooms, where classes are held, are regularly cleaned and disinfected.
- 12. Teachers remove objects and furniture that cannot be effectively disinfected from the teaching rooms.
- 13. Students do not bring with them unnecessary things and toys to class.
- 14. The students have the opportunity to choose online teaching.
- 15. The teacher disinfects instruments between classes and airs the classrooms.
- 16. The teacher draws attention to the regular washing of hands by the students.
- 17. The teacher is constantly watching children under the angle of the symptoms that may indicate COVID-19 infection.
- 18. In case of alarming symptoms in the child's teacher, with the consent of a parent, it can measure the temperature during classes.
- 19. In case of reasonable suspicion of possible contamination, the teacher must isolate the child from the group and notify the director and parents.
